	Subject: Driving Utility 8840	

The purpose of this guideline is to outline procedures for driving Utility 8840. Any driver shall:

- 1) Be an employee of the District (Career, Volunteer, or Intern).
- 2) Possess a current California Driver's License and Proof of Automobile Liability Insurance.
- 3) Be familiar with the Bodega Bay Map Book and radio operations procedures.
- 4) If not already approved by the Fire Chief to drive a District vehicle, undergo a supervised driving orientation.

Utility 8840 shall at all times be driven in compliance with State traffic laws and rules of the road and applicable segments of Bodega Bay Fire Protection District Standard Operating Guidelines 3a & 3b.

Utility 8840 shall be driven in Code 2 (non-emergent) mode unless responding to an imminent life or limb emergency and driven by a District employee who has completed EVOC training and is authorized by the Fire Chief to drive a District vehicle under Code 3 conditions.
