Each employee shall be provided with appropriate duty uniforms, duty jumpsuit (optional), wild land gear and structure gear.

Appropriate uniforms and times are as listed:

0800-0830	duty pants, duty uniform/BBFPD t-shirt/BBFPD sweatshirt
0830-0945	physical training/workout attire (shirt and shoes required)
0945-1700	duty uniform
1700-0800	duty uniform/sweatshirt or structure gear

The appropriate uniform shall be worn for the appropriate call. (i.e. structure gear for fire)

Duty uniform shall be defined as: issued T-shirt, dress shirt (with badge and insignias) and/or issued jacket, basket weave belt, dress pants, duty boots.

It is the responsibility of each **shift officer** to ensure enforcement and compliance with uniform policy on their respective shifts(s). Staff members habitually in non compliance shall be forwarded to the Assistant Chief or Fire Chief for disciplinary action.
