All medical incidents requiring the Fire District's EMTs or Paramedics to respond must have documentation generated for the following circumstances: Patient Contact(s), Against Medical Advice (AMA), Released at Scene (RAS), Private Transport, Cancelled Enroute, Unable to Locate (UTL), No Medical Merit, Dead on Arrival (DOA).

Documentation as specified shall be generated on all responses whether or not medical care was rendered. Terms for paperwork are as follows: NFIRS (National Fire Incident Reporting System), Pre-Hospital Care Report (PCR) and District Billing Form; Ambulance Services Transportation Record, District AMA and RAS Form.

Cancel Enroute or On Scene, Unable to Locate, No Patient Contact, No Medical Merit.	NFIRS
Patient Contact(s), Against Medical Advice, Release at Scene, Private Transport	District Billing Form AMA or RAS Form PCR NFIRS
Dead on Arrival	District Billing Form PCR NFIRS

All incidents which require a PCR to be generated shall follow the Pre-Hospital Care Reporting System SOG for distribution of that document.
