	Subject: Support Volunteers	

In Accordance with Bodega Bay Fire Protection District Administrative Policy Manual, Support Volunteers are designated as non-safety members who may provide support functions under the direction of the Fire Chief or On Duty Officer, so long as proper training has occurred and been documented.

Support Volunteers may elect to participate in specific area of work as outlined in the volunteer track below. Volunteers may have expertise in a certain area or a desire not to participate in all aspects of District incident response. Specific areas of work currently available are as an EMS volunteer, a Marine Volunteer, and an auxiliary communications volunteer.

- EMS Volunteers are those that wish to participate specifically in the EMS field and respond as a part of the ambulance, engine, or rescue crew in the event of a medical emergency.
- Marine Volunteers are those that wish to respond as part of the boat crew.
- Auxiliary Communications Volunteers are those that wish to participate with radio communications as needed for training, drills, and disasters.

Support volunteers are limited to those areas as outlined in the Administrative Policy Manual (APM) and the following with additional training:

- Medical care
- Traffic control
- Rehab
- Fire ground support
- Incident response
- Boat Operations
- Communications

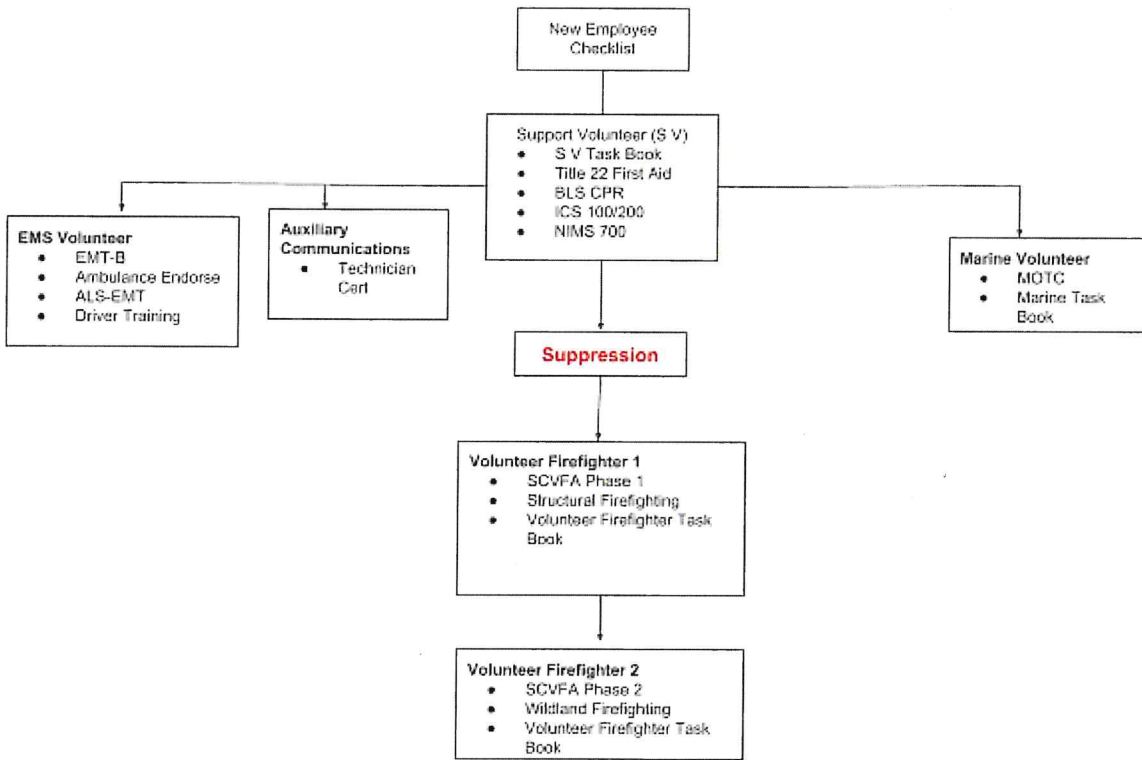
Upon applying for a Volunteer position with the Fire District, the prospective volunteer can choose the path and position they desire to follow. All prospective volunteers shall be required to complete the first two steps of the track as outlined below before incident response and specific area training can occur.
