	Subject: Marin County Response	

The Bodega Bay Fire Protection District has an agreement with the Marin County Fire Department to provide ALS ambulance to the northern portion of Marin County. This area encompasses Dillon Beach and most of Tomales.

REDCOM and Woodacre will dispatch M811. Response shall be made on the appropriate Control channel or by MDC, M811 should also respond on Marin Local. All normal radio communications should be made on both the Control channel and on Marin Local.

When transporting to a Marin County hospital, notification to the receiving facility shall be made via cell phone since BBFPD does not have the proper radio equipment to make radio contact with Marin hospitals. Additionally, notification shall be made to the on duty officer advising of transport destination outside of Sonoma County.

When M811 responds to Marin County for a fire incident, Medic 811 will primarily be used as an ALS stand-by unit but may be used for suppression as directed by the incident commander.

For ocean-based incidents, response should be coordinated with MRN and USCG to determine victim location and the end destination (Sonoma or Marin County) of the victim(s). Captains should consider responding to Station Bodega Bay to aid with response and coordination.

A Marin County/Tomales area map books are located in M811/M812 and the fire station for reference.

All ambulance billing forms shall indicate "MARIN COUNTY" for billing purposes.

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
