As a member agency of the Sonoma Coast First Responders Group, BBFPD has assisted with the development and implementation of the SCIRP. A three year long effort was made to bring agencies together and adopt common goals and create operational efficiencies. All agencies represented in the plan have agreed to cooperation and implementation of the plan.

BBFPD personnel will adhere to and utilize the plan as a guide when responding to emergencies and mitigating incidents on the Sonoma Coast as outlined in the plan.

Quarterly meetings will be held to ensure an open flow of communications to all agencies involved and to discuss current issues or after action reviews to improve efficiencies by all.

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# SONOMA COUNTY COASTAL INCIDENT RESPONSE PLAN

## RESCUE EVENT RESPONSE CHECKLIST

- Confirmation of Unified Ordering Point (UOP)
- Confirm Command & Tactical Nets (Primary & Secondary)
- Confirm proper notifications have been made

### Upon arrival at scene

- Report on Conditions to UOP
- Establish Incident Command
- Evaluate resource needs

## REPORT ON CONDITIONS

- Confirmation of incident location
- Update event type if required
- Number of victims and extent of injuries
- Actions being taken
- Advise to continue/ discontinue normal resource deployment, or specify resource needs
- Best access route and staging area

**Unified Ordering Point (UOP)- REDCOM will be UOP for all rescue events**

## Rescue event types

### Rescue (RESCUE)

Any event which may require retrieval of a patient from an otherwise non accessible location. Since we do not use the Confined Space, High and Low Angle rescue event types, anything that fits this criteria would be done under this event type.

Examples: An industrial or construction site accident involving an entrapment where the victim(s) may be buried under dirt, sand, grain, gravel, debris or a fall from a cliff at the beach, or structural collapse.

### Ocean Rescue (RES-OC)

Any report of a person or vessel in distress in the OCEAN WATER ONLY.

### Swift water Rescue (RES-SW)

Any report of a person trapped in moving water with no escape. Generally associated with river or flood waters.

### Boat Accident (SCSO event type)

Any incident involving the collision of a boat or multiple boats where the occupants have become injured but remain in the vessel and do not require rescue but may require care or assistance.
