



	Subject: Response Matrix and ESZ's	

Per REDCOM SOG's, BBFPD has established Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) response matrices broken down by Emergency Service Zones (ESZ's). Each ESZ represents a geographical area with its own individual risks and therefore required resources vary.

A chief officer or the on-duty company officer may change the response at any time during an incident.

The attached sheets contain the most current BBFPD dispatch matrix information. The following is a list of current ESZ's.
